### II. Procedure

#### A. Mid-Tenure Review

A list of tenure-track faculty to be reviewed within each college or school should be kept in the dean's office where the list is available to faculty and the Peer Review Committee. A chart for each department/school/college is also kept in the Office of Academic Affairs.

# a. Preparation for Mid-Tenure Review

Faculty scheduled for Mid-Tenure peer review should follow the normal tenure and promotion file format in the *Faculty Manual*, except for the following:

- 1. Outside reviewers are not needed and letters of support are not needed.
- 2. Any voting materials are not included in the file
- 3. Files are not forwarded past the dean (if sent to the dean).

## b. Review Process

1. According to the current *Faculty Manual*, faculty in the tenure-track are to have Mid-Tenure Review peer reviews completed in the fall of their third year or fourth year, with November 23 as the date for completion.

- 2. Mid-Tenure peer reviews are completed by the department/college/school Peer Review Committee. Some departments/college/schools send the review to the Dean's office for review.
- 3. Once completed, the original peer review form is forwarded to the Office of Academic Affairs for posting of review and for filing in the faculty member's Evaluation file. The department/college/school should keep a copy in their file.

# B. Extension of Probationary Period/Extension of Timetable for Mid-Tenure Review

If a faculty member has asked for and been approved for an extension of the probationary period during the first three years of tenure-track status, the mandatory third year peer review can also be delayed (per *Faculty Manual* and ACAF 1.31).
