Requirements:

- Sociology GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Completion of at least 4 sociology courses at USC Upstate prior to initiation

How to Apply:

Each initiate shall pay an initiation fee of \$40.00, which entitles the initiate to a lifetime membership in *AKD*, a membership certificate, and a one-year subscription to the journal *Sociological Inquiry*.
