This report displays retention and graduation rates for students who entered Upstate in the fall as first-time, fulltime, degree seeking undergraduate students.

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
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Retention


First-time Full-time retention rate is the percentage of first-time in college, full-time degree-seeking students who continue at the school the next fall.

4-Year Graduation Rates
