Date	Workshop Title	What to expect?	Pre-Workshop Task:
Sept. 6	Intros and Finding Money!	Learn how SARS (the office, not the disease) can help you! Learn how to use Pivot to find money. Learn how to read/understand a call for proposal.	'Elevator pitch'. A develop a 2 min. oral proposal providing the basic elements of their RISE project. Be prepared to share with the group
Sept. 13	Grant Writing: What, why, how and knowing thy audience	Learn about the basic aspects of grant writing and persuasive writing. Writing significance and impact sections/statements. Answering what and why.	Rough draft/outline of the background and significance of the proposed idea, including its relation to the present state of knowledge in the field.
Sept. 27	Dream BIG! ...Now dial it Back	Building a Feasible Project (objectives, timelines, deliverables)	Create logic model for objectives -> activities -> outcomes
Oct. 11	Time to talk Budget	Let's build a budget and understand fringe (!?!).	Create a budget using the available RISE budget form.
Oct 25	Methods for Dummies (not you...the reviewer!)	Writing methods section (the 'how') that are accessible by your audience.	Draft of methods section
Nov. 8	Putting it all together!	Grant writing vs academic writing. Connecting the pieces together. Discussion of the CV and current & pending support forms	Develop an advanced draft of 2-page CV and complete the current & pending support form
Nov. 22	Mock Review Panel/Peer Review	Participants will review each other's proposals using the scoring rubric. Discussion to follow.	Build a full draft of the RISE proposal (including all forms) to be submitted for the mock review panel
Dec. 6	USCeRA Fun Times!	Ins and Outs of USCeRA. Learn how to (and) submit your RISE proposal.	Use feedback to finalize the proposal.
