UPD

Title IX

Notification

Call/report received

Immediate response for health/safety & referrals

Report received

Outreach to offer services, supports, explain process

Victim Advocacy

Contact with UPD Victim Advocate; Possible forensic exam
Referral to Project REST; Referral to Title IX; Safety plan created

Meeting to discuss options and set up supports
Referral to UPD Advocate and Project REST

Process Decision

Victim options explained; Possible gathering of evidence

Complainant decides on process; Other party/ies notified; Investigator identified

Investigation

Interviews held; collection of evidence; officer makes determination to seek a warrant; determination discussed with victim; arrest may occur

Advisors identified/assigned; Hearing Officer assigned; Investigative Interviews with parties and witnesses; draft report completed & reviewed; Final report shared

Hearing/Court Processes

Prosecutor decision on moving forward; Possible bond hearing(s); Possible plea bargain and/or jury trial; possible conviction & sentencing

Hearing scheduled & pre-hearing meetings held; Hearing held & decision shared; Sanctions identified; If appealed, appeal completed

Post-Process

Victim Advocates continue to provide support as needed

Supports continue as needed; Sanction follow-up as needed; Case marked as closed
