All courses transferred for degree credit must have a minimum grade of "C" 2. Professional program related pre-requisite courses may not be included in the Associate's of Art or Sciences completion pathway. 3. A supplemental application and testing required for upper-division courses in the School of Education, Human Performance, and Health. 4. Courses excluded from general transfer must be completed prior to upper-level courses.
